



## California Proposition 65 Statement

The declaration below is applicable to all Pletronics parts except OCXO's and GT11

Prop 65 requires "clear and reasonable" warnings to be given if, in the course of doing business, a person knowingly and intentionally exposes an individual in California to a chemical on the Prop 65 List. Prop 65 also prohibits knowingly discharging or releasing a chemical on the Prop 65 List such that it is likely to, or will, enter any California drinking water source.

Pletronics uses supplier provided materials declarations substance information, and to the best of our knowledge, our products do not expose any person to any chemical on the Prop 65 List nor are any such chemicals discharged or released into any drinking water source during normal product use.

None of the substances in Pletronics parts, namely cobalt (non-powder form) and nickel, violate the exposure or Safe Harbor limits as listed on the California proposition 65, Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986. These substances are part of an alloy and thus not subject to this proposition.

OCXO's and GT11 may also contain Lead which is in glass of chip resistors and may also be in solder. This substance is not discharged or released during normal product use.
